Ribbons: A green/white rosette will be given to each dog that passes the Qualified Courser Test and the Junior Courser Test.

TESTS OFFERED

Junior Courser (Test 1 and 2): Open to all all hounds 12 months of age or older. Hounds will be expected to complete a (minimum) 600-yard course with a minimum of 4 turns. The hound must complete the entire course with enthusiasm and without interruption. A Junior Courser Title is awarded to hounds completing two legs of a JC test under two separate judges. Requirements for the JC title may be met at this event.

Qualified Courser (Test): A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) - shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course.

Bitches in season and lame hounds at roll call will be excused and their entry fee refunded. Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period.

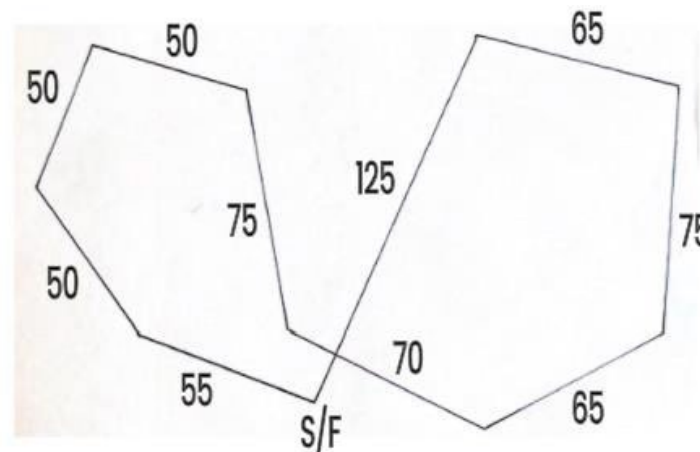
Course Plan

(Course is not fully fenced and can be changed at Judges and field committee's discretion for safety of the dogs)

Monday April 17, 2023 -665 yards

Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic strips or bags. Backup equipment will be available. The members of IWCA reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the date of the trial.

The lure will be reversed for JC test 2.



Directions: McKinney is located approximately 33 miles northeast of downtown Dallas via U.S. Highway 75 (North Central Expressway). From U.S. Highway take the Highway 75, take the Highway 308 exit and head West approximately 2.5 miles until you reach FM 1461. Turn right (NORTH) on FM 1461 and travel approximately 3.8 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (NORTH) on County Road 166. Go about a mile. You will see the MPEC on your left. DO NOT TURN IN. Continue until you reach the stop sign at County Rd 168. Turn Left (west) onto County Road 168. On the left you will see the MPEC offices and a large metal barn. Continue past that area to the next gate on your left. Turn left into that gate. Look for The IWCA Signs.
