Trial Hours:

Trial starts at 12:00 PM for All Breed & 1:00 PM for Irish Wolfhounds. Check-in for dogs belonging to the field committee will begin NLT 30 minutes before published trial hours.

Set up will begin at 10:00 AM. We need volunteer throughout the events for line judges, foul judges, and catch/release.

Some certification runs may be allowed before the trial.

The handler presenting the certifying hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course.

ROLL CALL AND INSPECTION

Inspections: 11:00 AM All Breed, 12:30 PM for Irish Wolfhounds

Roll Call 11:30 AM for All Breed and 12:45 for Wolfhounds. Hounds not present at roll call will be marked absent and are not eligible for refund of entry fee.

RACE INFORMATION

This will be a hand slipped meet. No boxes will be available. All hounds will run muzzled. USRCC does not provide muzzles.

A limited number of racing jackets in various sizes will be available from USRCC.

Only the following colors shall be used:

Red Jacket – White numeral "1" White Jacket – Black numeral "3"

Blue Jacket – White numeral "2" Green Jacket – White numeral "4"

ENTRY FEES

Pre-Entries: the entry fee for the first hound will be \$20.00 and \$15.00 for each additional hound with the same owner must be received by the Race Secretary by **5pm the Thursday prior to the meet. E-mail entries will be accepted, payment can be made via PayPal or Venmo for an additional \$2 fee per entry.**

LGRA ELIGIBLE HOUNDS

Hounds must be one year of age or older to be entered. All hounds must be registered with LGRA.

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Chart Polski, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Magyar Agar, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo Medio/Grande, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, and Sloughi may be entered in an Official Race Meet held under these Rules and Regulations.

Whippets:

Volunteers

We need volunteers! This meet cannot run without the help of volunteers. If you are willing to help at our race meet by line or foul judging for the day you are welcome **to practice 1 run** in between programs 2 & 3. We cannot allow an unlimited number of practices between programs due to daylight constraints and the fact that this is a competition, and the racers take priority. If time and volunteers are permitting at the end of the meet, more practice runs may be offered.

WHAT IS LGRA?

LGRA is sprint racing for Gazehounds. The hounds run 200 yards straight after a lure consisting of a fur bag and squawker. Up to four hounds race a total of three times, called programs. Depending on the order of finish, they may attain national points towards a GRC, Gazehound Race Championship title.

The Meet Secretary may require a qualifying run for FTEs not having a qualifying run certificate, proof of ASFA certification, or proof of an AKC QC.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Race Site: The grounds being used for this race are not completely flat.

* BRING WATER AND SHADE FOR YOUR HOUNDS.

* A \$5.00 fine will be assessed to the owner or handler of any hound loose on the field but not competing in the race in progress.

*** If your dog is not registered with LGRA you must provide a copy of your dog's AKC registration (or foreign registration) and a one-time \$2.00 registration fee.**

REGISTRATION WITH LGRA

All hounds must be registered with LGRA. The hounds must be individually registered with a recognized registry for purebred Gazeounds to register with LGRA.

The following registrations are approved by LGRA: American Kennel Club (AKC), Canadian Kennel Club (CKC), United Kennel Club (UKC), National Greyhound Association (NGA), or any recognized foreign registry for pure-bred progeny of Gazehound breed. Hounds registered with the AKC under Indefinite listing Privilege (ILP) or the CKC equivalent may also be registered.

General Information:

There will be a porta-potty on site. Bring your own food, water and shade. No littering. Pick up after your dogs, and please haul your garbage off the field. There will be a fine for NOT leaving the field as you found it. Due to the proximity of neighbors to the parking area, dogs may not be off leash except when competing.

USRCC welcomes spectators, but asks that all spectators and exhibitors adhere to LGRA and USRCC standards of conduct. Any spectator or exhibitor that behaves in an inappropriate manner will be asked to leave the trial site.
