Guidelines for the IWCA Multi-Titlist Award Program

The purpose of this IWCA Multi-Titlist Award program is to encourage the participation of Irish Wolfhound owners and their Irish Wolfhounds in performance events, acknowledge the achievements of the Irish Wolfhound/handler teams that meet the Multi-Titlist Award criteria, and inspire them to progress to the IWCA Versatility program. The Multi-Titlist Certificate and Medallion are given to those members' hounds that have earned the required titles.

Multi-Titlist Award Criteria:

A minimum of one title in three of the Versatility Program Guideline Groups from A to G and at least six titles overall (all groups).

An application can be submitted for any living Irish Wolfhound (or within 6 months of their death) whose owner is a member in good standing of the Irish Wolfhound Club of America. Titles may be earned over more than one calendar year. Refer to the IWCA Versatility Program Guidelines or the application below for title listings. The Performance and Versatility Committee will review applications for credit/titles in activities not listed in any group on an individual basis. Information supplied to the Performance and Versatility Committee must include proof of credit, rules of the sanctioning organization and an explanation of the sport or activity for additional miscellaneous titles.
