Entries not on OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS (or photocopies or electronic copies of same which do not include the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side) are not acceptable.

#### ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED:

- In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the show committee
- For duplicate entries
- If the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club or show secretary

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by e-mail JDC\_ShowSecretary@msn.com prior to close of entries. Those received verbally by telephone are not acceptable.

The A.K.C. will collect the above fees for each 1<sup>st</sup> Entry of a dog & each Additional Entry of the same dog in regular & non-regular recordable single entry classes in all A.K.C. Licensed & Member Club Events. Event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all fees for the A.K.C. & payment of all fees to the A.K.C. as stipulated in AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Ch 11, Sec 2

- The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause, and no person shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.
- There will be no drilling or intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. NO DOUBLE HANDLING will be permitted at this show. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. There is no
  provision for unentered dogs at this show. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show
  Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class
  judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the
  presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be picked up at the show, none will be mailed.

All awards will be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, to the person exhibiting the dog and that
person shall be considered the rightful winner of the award. The Show Secretary should be advised of any award
discrepancies.

#### Effective January 1, 2015 -- USE OF RAMPS: A CLARIFICATION

BACKGROUND The appropriate place to individually examine dogs during breed judging is designated by each parent club and AKC does not pre-empt their authority in this regard. RAMP BREEDS A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the show superintendent/ show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. Designated ramp breeds may be examined on the ground (table if applicable) or on a ramp during breed, group and Best in Show judging at the sole discretion of the judge, not the exhibitor. Examination for a breed must be consistent; therefore the entire entry in that breed is to be examined on the ground (table) or on a ramp. By Board approved policy, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs and Chows must be judged on the ramp in all conformation competition associated with AKC conformation dog shows or at which AKC conformation titles may be earned. This policy extends to Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. The list of Table and Ramp breeds can be found on the AKC Website under Conformation Judges - Announcements. ALL OTHER BREEDS Breeds not designated as either table or ramp breeds may only be examined on the ground. EMERGENCIES In emergency situations, with the approval of the Show Chair, breeds customarily examined on the ground may be examined on a ramp, not on a table. An emergency is defined as a temporary condition that arose immediately prior to or at a dog show. Convalescence from a medical procedure, illness and recuperation from injuries are examples of conditions that are not emergencies. The emergency use of a ramp may be allowed on a day and may be extended to include a cluster as well as judging either a group and/or Best In Show. ( In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund ). IRISH WOLFHOUNDS ARE NOT A RAMP DESIGNATED BREED

NOTE: RAMPS CAN BE USED IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS TO JUDGE ANY BREED

- THE SHOW GIVING CLUB, THE SHOW SECRETARY, THEIR AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, ETC. ASSUME NO RESPONSIBILITY

- NOTICE WAIVER OF RIGHTS: ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW HEREBY WAIVE ANY CLAIM FOR DAMAGES AGAINST THE CLUB, ITS MEMBERS OR SHOW SECRETARY, IN THE EVENT A MOTOR VEHICLE OR CRATE HAS TO BE ENTERED TO RESCUE A DOG FROM OVERHEATING OR IMPROPERLY VENTED CONDITIONS.

NOTE: 1st Place winners of Veteran Dog / Bitch & Field Trial Dog / Bitch Classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed IF undefeated in any other class at this show

Dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry. Brace must be marked as an "Additional Class". If more than one Brace is entered by an individual owner, please designate dogs comprising each Brace as "Brace # 1", "Brace # 2", etc.

TEAM CLASS ...... Fee is \$20.00 as a unit Effective 1/1/05 - Four dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers.

All dogs in the Team must have at least one common owner. All dogs in the Team must be entered in another class at this show.

Dogs comprising a Team must be named at the time of entry. Team must be marked as an "Additional Class". If more than one Team is entered by an individual owner, please designate dogs comprising each Team as "Team # 1", "Team # 2", etc.

NOTE:

As the judges decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace & Team Classes is based upon the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes.

The following RMIWA CHALLENGE TROPHIES are offered through The Rocky Mountain Irish Wolfhound Association for competition at its show only and for permanent possession must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive shows. **OPEN SENIOR CLASS** for boys and girls at least 15 & under 18 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS Effective 1 / 1 / 2018: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

The winner of a third first place in each Novice Class shall automatically become eligible to enter the corresponding Open Class at the show, provided the win is the third first place with competition and further provided there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in that Open Class.

Eligibility of Dog: Section 7. Effective 1 / 1 / 2018: Each dog entered in a regular Junior Showmanship Class at an All-breed dog show must be an AKC recognized breed or FSS Breed with an AKC number and at least 6 months of age on the day of the event. A Limited Breed Dog Club, Group Show, has the option to offer the opportunity for a Junior to show any breed eligible to be entered at an All-breed event or a breed eligible to compete in that event including the Miscellaneous Class breeds. At Specialty Shows, only the breed for the specialty is eligible to be entered. Dogs may be PAL/ILP, Full-, or Limited-Registered to compete in Junior Showmanship Classes, additionally, spayed and neutered specimens are eligible for competition. A Foreign dog, from a registry accepted by AKC for Registration, of an AKC Recognized breed is eligible to be entered on its Foreign Number. The dog must be entered in one of the classes associated with the event or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. An eligible dog other than the one entered may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. The junior must have the AKC number of the substitute dog. All such substitutions must be made with the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or coowned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, or grandmother, including the corresponding step and half relations, or by a permanent member of the Junior Handler's household as recorded with The American Kennel Club at the time entries close or an application for transfer of ownership must be sent to The American Kennel Club by the new owner within seven days after the last day of the show. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.

A Junior is limited to one substitute on at a dog show. If one of the owners of the dog is a judge, the dog may be entered in Junior Showmanship Only to be exhibited by the Junior at an event where the judge is judging classes other than Junior Showmanship.


